

SIDRA Certification and Assessment Procedures

Candidates who complete the SIDRA Professional Mediation Skills course will receive a SIDRA Certificate of Completion and be certified as a SIDRA Mediator.

Candidates who wish to apply for Singapore International Mediation Institute (SIMI) Level 1 Accreditation or Australian accreditation through the University of Western Australia may request a Mediator Assessment from SIDRA. Candidates who pass the Assessment and receive SIMI Level 1 Accreditation also enjoy a pathway to International Mediation Institute (IMI) Certification. The Assessment has three components: 1) a Roleplay; 2) a Reflective Practice; and 3) a Written Exam. Candidates must satisfy **all three components** of the Assessment in order to pass and receive SIMI Level 1 Accreditation:

- Roleplay:** Candidates will be evaluated on each core skill within a 1-5 value scale (5 = demonstrating exceptional competence, 1 = not yet demonstrating competence).
- Reflective Practice:** Candidates will submit two brief self-reflective essays; one completed before, and one completed after the Roleplay. This component of the assessment encourages candidates to evaluate their own expectations and performance and demonstrate their ability to self-reflect on their actions.
- Written Exam:** The written exam will be based upon the course content covered in classroom training and will measure candidates' awareness of core mediation skills. The exam will be multiple choice format and true/false statements.

(Candidates may request a remote assessment if the candidate is not based in Singapore, or an in-person assessment in Singapore at a venue to be secured by SIDRA).
